NOTES

Only genuine applications made under the 'Humber Estuary Trawl Permit' provisions will be considered. All applications must be supported by clear evidence of catching a minimum of 500 Kg of finfish or shrimp from within the Humber Estuary in any three month period between 1 January 2013 and 31 December 2015. Any applications without such evidence will not be considered.

Any application received after Monday 17 February 2020 will not be considered.

Successful applicants must prove the following:

1. The vessel is registered as a fishing vessel in accordance with Part II of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995 and the regulations made thereunder (or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof), or in the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man and who holds a valid current fishing licence issued by the appropriate U.K Fisheries Department at the time the application is made.
2. The vessel does not exceed 18.3m overall length and 400 KW engine power.
3. The vessel possesses a current valid permit to trawl within the Authority's District issued under paragraphs 2 or 3 of Byelaw III 'Trawling:Prohibition:Exceptions'
4. The vessel possesses a track record of catching a minimum of 500 Kg of finfish or shrimp from within the Humber Estuary between 1 January 2013 and 31 December 2015.
5. Applications must be received by Monday 17 February 2020.

All Successful applicants will be notified in writing and a fee of £500 will be charged. It is a condition of holding the permit that the fee is paid in full upon each successful application or renewal. Non-payment of the fee will invalidate the permit.
