Only genuine applications made under Paragraph 2a of byelaw XXVIII will be considered. All applications must be supported by clear evidence of fishing for crustacea using pots within the NEIFCA district and that catches of lobster and crab have been registered with NEIFCA since 2016. Any applications without such evidence will not be considered.

Any application received after Monday 10 February 2020 will not be considered.

Successful applicants must prove the following:

1. The vessel is registered as a fishing vessel in accordance with Part II of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995 and the regulations made thereunder (or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof), or in the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man and who holds a valid current fishing licence issued by the appropriate U.K Fisheries Department at the time the application is made.
2. The vessel does not exceed 14m overall length.
3. The vessel has fished for crustacea using pots within the NEIFCA district.
4. The vessel has registered catches of lobster and crab with NEIFCA since 2016
5. Applications must be received by Monday 10 February 2020.

All Successful applicants will be notified in writing.
